

Genetic Screening Testing

A New Beginning Options Offered:

Aneuploidy Screening: Checks for common genetic conditions caused by extra or missing chromosomes in a baby's DNA. Conditions like Downs Syndrome, Edwards Syndrome, Turners Syndrome. Will tell you the sex of the baby.

Carrier Screening: Screens for genes associated with specific inherited genetic conditions, including commonly screened conditions such as cystic fibrosis, spinal muscular atrophy, fragile X and sickle cell anemia.

Average cost for commercial insurance for Aneuploidy AND Carrier = \$100-\$150

Medicaid = \$0

Cash pay for both tests combined = \$349 max

*For commercial and cash paying patients, a financial assistance form can be submitted either when the blood is sent in OR after they get a bill. Form given at time of blood draw.

*Some patients who have met their co-pays and deductibles later in the calendar year, might not get a bill or pay less than the estimate of \$100-\$150.

Alpha-Fetoprotein (AFP): Blood test done at 15-22 weeks gestation to check the baby's risk of neural tube defects.
